

## **Notes for Remembrance Day Parade – Sunday 13<sup>th</sup> November**

### **Dress:**

Dress will be full No 2's – this is wedgewood blue shirt, tie and jersey. Poppy's are to be worn, you can obtain Poppy's for a small donation from supermarkets, petrol stations and some larger newsagents. Poppy's are to be worn centrally & immediately below the right shoulder patch on the jersey. Poppy's are also usually sold for a small fee on the main gate. Please bring your jeltex jackets & black gloves.

### **Timings:**

Arrive at the Squadron HQ at 1000hrs, the parade will start at 1050hrs and finish with a march past at 1150/1200hrs. You can depart immediately after the parade. You will need to bring your 3822 with you, parents are free to stay and watch but they do not need any identification. No vehicle access, car parking or dropping off directly in front of the main gates is allowed on Sunday morning.

### **Protection from the elements:**

To help you get through the parade without fatigue or illness it is imperative that you take note of the following:

**YOU MUST HAVE A LARGE HOT BREAKFAST  
YOU MUST DRINK AROUND 1 LITRE OF HOT OR COLD FLUID  
IF COLD YOU MUST WEAR A THERMAL LAYER UNDER YOUR SHIRT**

### **Junior Cadets:**

You are welcome to join us for this parade but you may not be marching. You will still have to observe the same timings; you will not need any identification to gain access. Your dress for the day will be warm smart clothing – trousers/shirt/tie with a jumper & jacket. Do not forget your Poppy's.

### **NCO's:**

Please remember to collect the order of service from the main gate & to make a note of who attended the parade (not on the weekly register, do it on a separate piece of paper).
