

## Summer Camp Kit List

- Take your kit in one bag or suitcase, with your uniform hung up in a carrier/bin liner. Also take a small day sack for the journey/days trips etc.
- Ensure your 3822 is fully signed up – especially for shooting, do you have a current WHT?
- Camp money must be in CASH to hand over on the bus
  
- 3822 with photo (you cannot get on an RAF station without it)
- Full blue uniform:
  - Beret
  - Dark blue shirts (minimum x 3)
  - Light blue shirt
  - Tie
  - Trousers & belt (males)
  - Skirt (females) – can take trousers too but MUST have skirt
  - Jumper
  - Brassard
  - Jeltex jacket
  - Shoes
  - Black socks for trousers
  - Barely black tights for skirts
- DPM's:
  - DPM jacket
  - DPM trousers
  - DPM or olive green shirt
  - Olive green T-shirt (minimum x 2)
  - Jumper (optional, handy for night ex)
  - Boots
  - Any other green kit normally worn
- Coveralls
- Sports kit & trainers
- Swimming kit & towel
- Old sports kit & trainers for getting dirty (water/mud etc)
- Comfy civvies & footwear for navigation walks
- Civvie waterproof
- Wash kit & towel
- Bun nets/hairgrips etc. (if required)
- Civilian clothes for evenings and on days out (no offensive t shirts or ripped jeans)
- Nightclothes!
- Sleeping bag
- Travel iron (if you have one, as irons at camp are limited - or share one)
- Alarm clock or similar
- Pens & notepad
- Sewing kit
- Shoe cleaning kit
- Padlock with 2 keys (one to hand in, for when you lose your one!)
- Coat hangers
- Spending money (your responsibility)
  
- You can take personal kit, cameras, music players etc. if you want, but all personal kit is your responsibility.
